Milford Commandery No. 11 College Scholarship

To be an eligible applicant, you must be a CHILD or GRANDCHILD of a current member or deceased member of good standing of Milford Commandery No. 11.

All scholarship applications must be received by <u>APRIL 1st</u>, <u>2020</u>. Selection will be made in May and the recipients will be notified at the time of selection. Checks for the awards will be payable to the student after evidence indicating enrollment for the first semester of the academic year 2020/2021 is received. A receipted <u>tuition bill</u> for the semester charges will suffice for evidence of enrollment. Checks will be mailed in August. The person awarded the scholarship will be invited to be the Commandery's guest at an awards ceremony to be held in June.

The eligibility requirements for a Milford Commandery No. 11 Scholarship are as follows:

- 1. Scholarships will be awarded only to those students who have graduated from high school and who are enrolled full time in a course of higher education at an accredited two or four year college. Before the scholarship is awarded, **the applicant must provide proof of enrollment**.
- 2. Each applicant must submit a personal letter in which the applicant sets forth his or her reasons for entering or continuing their higher education.
- 3. The applicant must furnish a current transcript from his or her high school or higher education institution, together with a testimonial from the principal, guidance counselor or advisor, as to their attendance and character.
- 4. The basis for the scholarships will be, but not limited to, the following criteria:

 (A) Economic Need (B) Scholastic Standing (C) Extracurricular Activities
- 5. All scholarship applications are for one year. Applications for subsequent Scholarships may be made in succeeding years. However, **preference will be given to graduating high school seniors entering their first year of higher education.**
- 6. If the Milford Commandery sponsor has passed away since sponsoring an applicant, please enter the date that he passed away. This will assist in verifying eligibility.
